## Health Guarantee

This contract is solely between Rainbow Row Labradoodles, LLC (Seller) and \_\_\_\_\_ (Buyer) and it entered on \_\_\_\_\_ (Date).

Pertaining to Puppy:

Seller agrees that Puppy is in good health at the time Buyer takes possession. Puppy will have age-appropriate vaccinations, de-worming, current on flea and heartworm prevention, microchipped, and come with a health certificate from Seller's licensed veterinarian of choice. Seller guarantees to the best of their knowledge that the sire and dam are free of congenital defects and are in good health.

Buyer has 3 business days to have Puppy seen by a licensed veterinarian of choice at Buyers expense. Failure to do so voids this contract. If the veterinarian finds Puppy has a life-threatening hereditary defect, Seller should be notified immediately and Puppy should be returned to Seller within 24 hours for a replacement puppy when one is available or a full refund of Purchase Price (not including shipping fees). Buyer must present a letter from diagnosing veterinarian stating the life-threatening hereditary defect on his/her letterhead. Seller reserves the right to have Puppy re-examined by a licensed veterinarian of choice before replacing/refunding Puppy.

Rainbow Row Labradoodles, LLC, will guarantee Puppy until he/she reaches 36 months of age from all serious genetic health impairments (meaning life-threatening or life-altering), which specifically includes severe hip dysplasia and Progressive Retinal Atrophy. If Puppy is diagnosed with a serious genetic health impairment and proper documentation is provided to Seller, Buyer has two options: return Puppy for a replacement puppy when one becomes available or keep Puppy and Seller will refund veterinary cost up to amount of Purchase Price of Puppy (not including shipping fees). Once the refund reaches Purchase Price of Puppy the guarantee contract expires and the Seller has no further monetary obligation to Buyer.

Severe Hip Dysplasia diagnosis:

This diagnosis can not be made by a veterinarian. It can only be made by The Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA) or Penn Hip. A copy of the OFA or Penn Hip report must be presented to Seller. This contract will be null and void if Buyer allowed Puppy to become overweight or allowed the developing joints to become overstressed or injured at any time during the guarantee period. We recommend you limit activity stressful to joints in the first 8 months as they are still developing. Improper diet can lead to joint damage. Buyer must feed puppy a high quality food (not bought in a grocery store) or this contract will be void.

Progressive Retinal Atrophy diagnosis:

This diagnosis can only be made by a veterinary ophthalmologist certified by the American College of Veterinary Medicine. The report must be presented to Seller.

Puppy that has been physically injured, ingestion of foreign objects, food, or chemicals is not covered by this contract. Fleas, worms, parasites, stress induced diarrhea, viral illnesses, bacterial infections, fungal infections, improper bites, hernias, dry skin, shedding, allergies, hypoglycemia, Giardia, and Coccidiosis are not covered by this contract. Buyer must not euthanize or dispose of Puppy in any way without a second opinion from Seller's veterinarian of choice or this contract will be void.

Puppy must be kept current on all vaccinations and veterinary care under a licensed veterinarian. Failure to do so will void this contract. Buyer must be properly caring for Puppy (reasonable exercise, diet, training, and medical care). Puppy must be housed indoors and not outdoors. Medical records will be requested in the event of replacement puppy or refund is requested.

In the unfortunate event of Puppy's death within 36 months, an autopsy must be performed by a licensed veterinarian and death determined to be caused by congenital defect free of environmental factors in order for a refund of Purchase Price to be paid to Buyer. The autopsy report must be presented to Seller. Contract is void in the event of indeterminable or inconclusive diagnoses.

This contract is non-transferable. If Puppy is sold or given away this contract becomes null and void.
